### Logbook of the World

Alan Dewey, KØAD, will tell us all about the ARRL's Logbook of the World.

Al was first licensed as KN9DHN in Munster, Indiana. Contesters he remembers from those Hoosier days in the early sixties include K1TN (then WA9AUM), W9RE (then WA9BWY) and K9LA (then WA9AVT). Al moved around a little and held the calls W1GBG and W0PFV before settling on KØAD in 1977. He has been an active contesteer for over 40 years often using just wires and verticals. With the addition of a tower and yagi in 2007, he has snuck into a few top ten boxes over the last year. Al recently retired as president of the very active Minnesota Wireless Association and also belongs to the Twin City FM Club, the
